Main objective	<p>The Recovery and Resilience Plan is a nationally applicable programme, with an exceptional implementation period lasting until 2026. The Plan will implement a set of reforms and investments aimed at restoring sustained economic growth, supporting the goal of convergence with Europe over the next decade. Its three main axis are Resilience (associated with an increase in the capacity to react to crises and overcome their associated current and future challenges), Climate Transition (a commitment and contribution to the climate targets that will enable it to reach carbon neutrality by 2050) and Digital Transition (significant reforms and investments are planned in the areas of digitalisation of companies, in the state and providing digital skills in education, health, culture, and forest management).</p>
